General Rules and Instructions

Entry Fee: \$40.00 per team

Chili Amount: All participants are required to prepare at least 3 gallons of chili. 16 oz. will be provided to the judges at 11:30 in a container provided. Small portion cups and spoons will be provided and persons with arm bands will be served from 11:30 to 2:00pm

Teams: Teams may be made up of an unlimited amount of members. 2 wristbands will be included with entry fee. 1 member from each team must attend the cook's meeting the morning of the event.

Cooking, Supplies, Safety: Teams are responsible for supplying all ingredients, cooking devices, tables, coolers, tents, serving utensils, etc. Each team will be allocated approximately 10 x 12 feet of space. Electricity will be provided.

Traffic/Parking: The park area will be opened for you to drop off your supplies at 7:30am and will be closed to all traffic at 9:00am. All vehicles must be removed from the park area by **9:00AM**.

Vehicles will be allowed back in the park area after 2:00pm. Site must be cleaned and cleared by 6:00pm.

Voting: People's choice award will be given to the team who garners the most votes. Guests will vote with cash at your space for the best chili of the day. The team with the most cash at the end of the day will be awarded the most prestigious People's Choice Award!

Judging: Chili will be judged by the following criteria: **Aroma, Appearance, Consistency, and Taste.** Awards are given for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place.

CHILI

Chili definition:

Whatever you call chili, we call chili. Chili may or may not contain beans. Chili can be red, white or any other color.

Chili may be prepared at home or on site. We encourage you to cook on site as it adds to the fun and atmosphere of the event.

All DHEC rules and regulations related to food preparation and distribution must be followed.

All wild game chili must be clearly labeled.

A complete set of rules will be provided to you after your team is registered.
